

Ref: National industrial strike action by teachers

Dear families,

I am writing regarding plans for the Teacher Industrial Action on Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May 2023.

We are only able to operate as a school when staffing numbers are at a safe level to support and meet the needs of our pupils. As a result of reduced staffing levels due to a number of reasons including staff taking strike action and those who need to look after their own children, multiple classes across the school will be closed over the two days.

Unless the industrial action is paused or resolved through agreed negotiations between teaching unions and the government, the school will close to a number of classes across the school over the two days. Please use the table below to check if your child's class will be open or closed on each of those days.
