- Fractions

Science

This term, we are learning about:

Earth in Space

- The order of the planets in our solar system and how they move in orbit around the sun.
- The work of scientists like Copernicus and Galileo in developing our knowledge of the solar system.
- The phases of the moon.



Wider Curriculum

History / geography - We will be exploring The Americas in our Geography unit after half term.

Music- The children will be learning to play the steel pans in preparation for their showcase later on in the term.

Art - This term, the children are learning about Retro-futurism (linking to our space theme as we focus on 1950's/1960's futuristic art). We will start by drawing and will end with printing. PE - Games, including football and tag rugby.

Computing - Coding - Designing a game to meet given criteria, including variables such as a timer. Online safety - developing their knowledge of appropriate online behaviour and how to protect themselves online.


French - In this subject, the children will be learning about methods of transport and how to describe journeys using their growing knowledge of the French language.
