Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you that Mrs Clarke will be going on maternity leave starting from Monday, 27th February and to share the plans for Year IC after half term.

Although there may be some changes to the timetable (which happens at various points in the academic year anyway) there will be no changes to the intended curriculum or how pupils are taught. In addition, if we notice that any pupils are struggling with the change from Mrs Clarke to the team around Year IC, we will ensure they receive the support they need.

If you have any questions about any of this, please let me know and I will feed responses back to parents and the Key Stage I team before half term.
